Day 1: November 2; Show your K in every Way Wear your Key Club spirit gear, post posters everywhere, travel throughout your community showing everyone your K


Day 2: November 3; Kudos to the Key Players Just like the A in our Project CARE, appreciate those who have helped your club and recognize their contribution
